The Bishopthorpe Camera Club group has been set-up so that members can submit photos which can only be seen by other members and not by the general public.

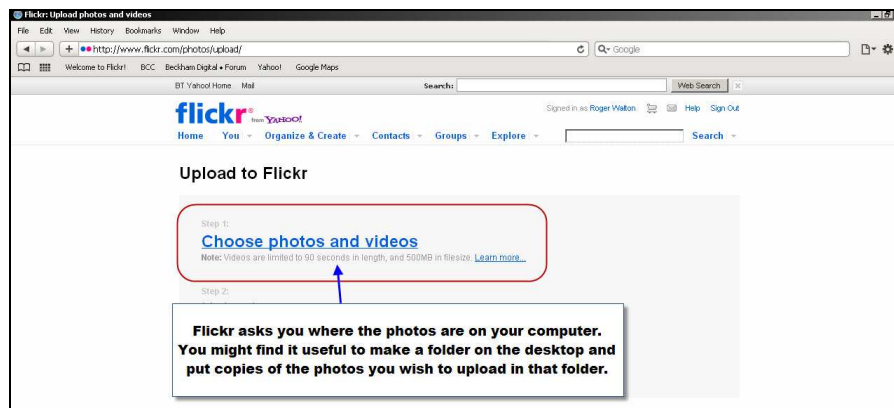
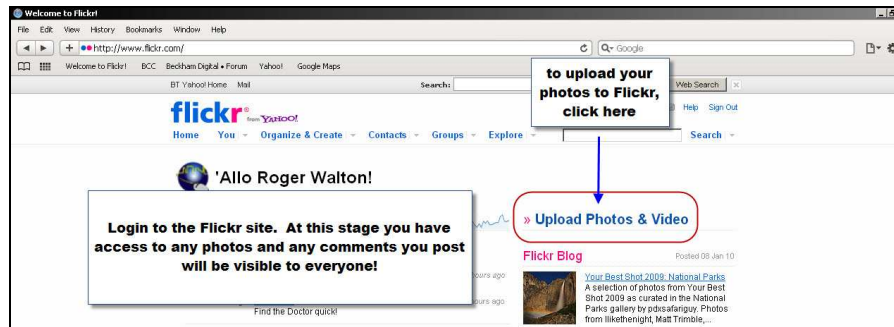
Any comments made on images submitted to the BCC private group will only be visible to other members of the group.

Here's how...

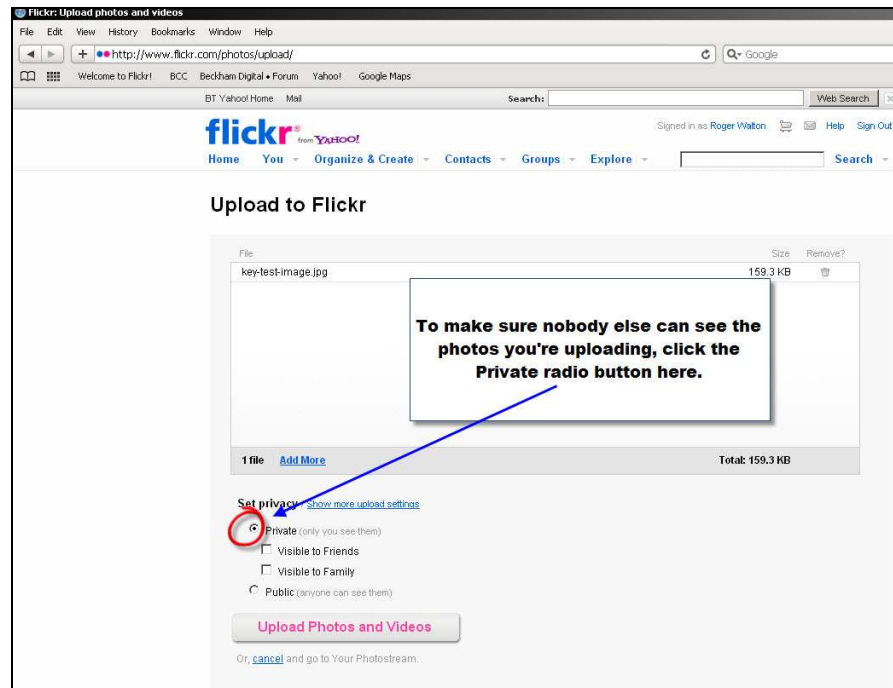
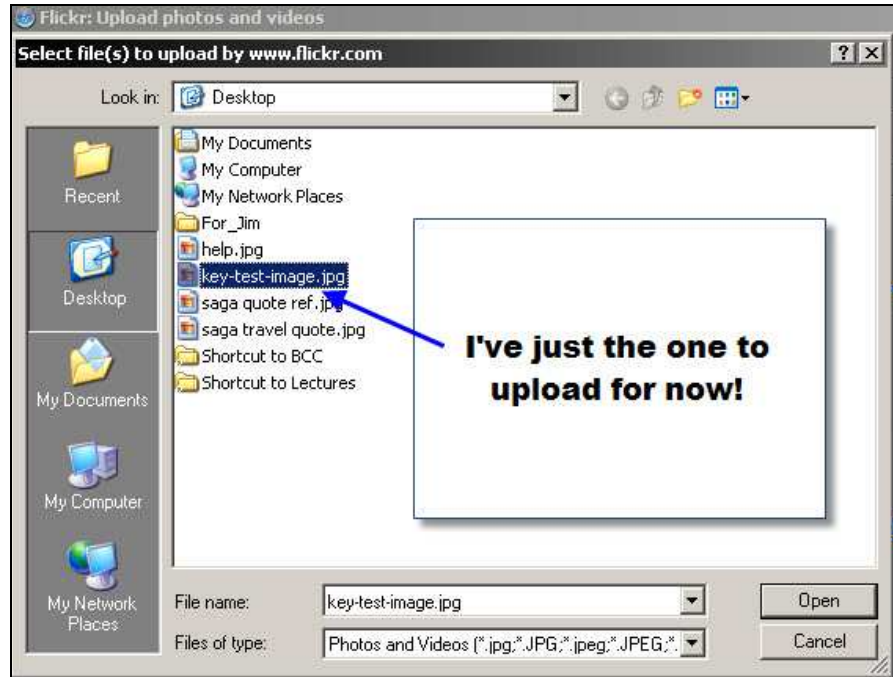
1. joining the group

To join the BCC group, you must already be a member of Flickr. Once registered with Flickr, e-mail BCC@bishopthorpe-camera-club.com and we'll send you a link that will allow you to join the private group.

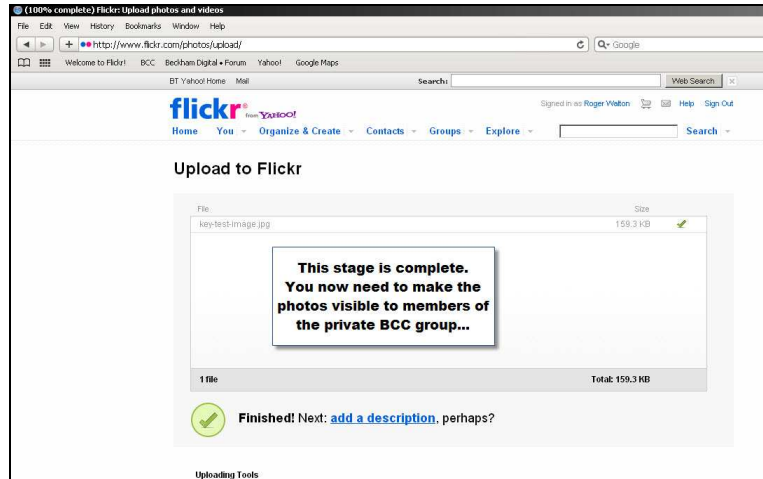
2. upload your pictures to Flickr – make them Private!

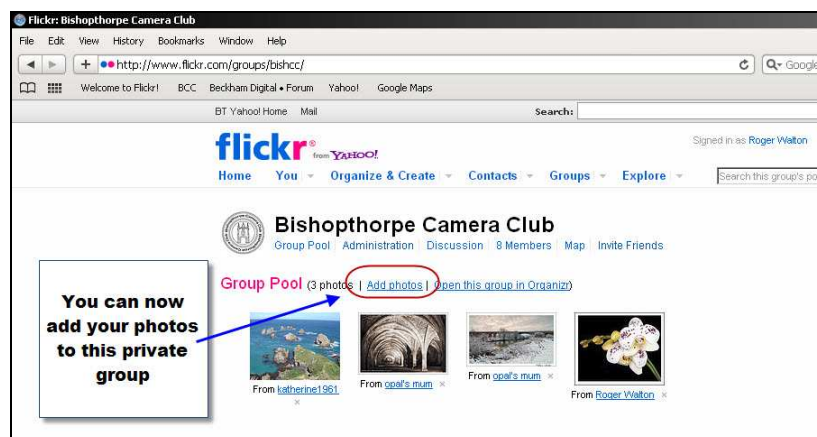
Uploading Photos to Flickr so that only BCC group members can see them.
