Paul Gallagher is a fine art photographer and lecturer working predominantly using large format equipment. His colour and monochrome images capture the magic of Northern England and the Scottish Highlands. ‘Lands of the North’ will focus on monochrome images encompassing Paul’s experiences ‘in the field’, stories behind the photographs and his methods of post-processing. There will be examples of Paul’s prints on display for people to see the end results.

He began his photographic career studying graphic design and photography at Southport College of Art, gaining a distinction in photography, following which he worked professionally in a commercial studio in Liverpool. Some years later, Paul was invited to return to teach photography part-time at Southport College. He is an Associate of the Royal Photographic Society.

Paul is a regular keynote speaker to Photographic Societies throughout the UK sharing his work, and techniques in both the use of large format equipment and fine art digital print production. His photographic work is widely published.
